Details

Reading Blocks in Kindergarten and 1st Grade run from 9am-10:30am; Math Blocks run right after school lunch.

We ask you to consider committing one hour a day, once a week, for the length of the school year. We acknowledge this is a significant investment of your time, but we are convinced this will be a wonderfully rewarding experience for you as well!

Tutors will need to pass a background check and attend a (fun!) late-afternoon training during the week of August 14th -18th (kids are welcome to hang out).

Tutoring begins the week of September 5th.

We'll also have a follow-up celebration at the end of the school year.
